# Ms. Langwald's Homework Philosophy and Policies 

## Philosophy

Homework in my class will be for your benefit. I will not give you "busy work" or waste your time. I am aware that you all have other classes you need to work on outside of class as well. In return I expect that you complete the homework by the assigned due date. I will do my best to limit homework, so you should not need to spend more than 20 to 30 minutes on algebra homework at night. You can expect to have three assignments a week to be done outside of class. Out of these three assignments, one of them will be graded on your work and the other two will be graded on completion. Because I do not have time to grade everything it is important that you ask questions when you are confused or need extra help.

## Policy

Homework is to be completed by the beginning of class on the day it is due. If it is not completed, you can submit within the next 24 hours for a reduced grade, which will be $20 \%$ subtracted from the total assignment. After 24 hours I will no longer accept that assignment because I will already have graded the rest of them and handed them back to your peers.

If you are absent, you will be allowed as many days to complete the assignment as you were absent (if you are gone for three days, you will have three days after returning to school to get your work in for full credit), not including weekends. After that period of time has passed, you will have 24 hours to hand in any other work for a reduced grade (20\% off). If you fail to get these assignments done within this time period, you will not be able to receive any credit for them.
